

Rules and Regulations

Inter-University Biology Quiz Competition – 2020

A competition for undergraduates organized by the Institute of Biology, Sri Lanka

1. Participants must be current undergraduates at a State university (this will be verified and any discrepancy may lead to the disqualification of the participant at any stage of the competition).
2. All correspondence related to the competition will be via email and the participant is responsible to provide correct email addresses and follow up.
3. The participants must adhere to the competition rules, regulations and guidelines with regard to Stage I (online examination) and for Stage II (if selected).
4. Stage I - online examination:
 - Institute of Biology reserves the right to change the date and time of the online examination if a need arises.
 - Participants cannot access any resources such as, but not limited to, external websites, other software applications, or hardcopy resources during the online examination.
 - The participant should not receive any assistance from an expert or any other person during the online examination.
 - The examination panel reserves the right to disqualify a participant at its sole discretion if there is evidence of cheating or failing to follow the exam rules and regulations during the online examination.
5. The decision of the examination panel is final and incontestable (for both Stage I and II).
6. The organizers assume no responsibility for computer related or network connection related errors or failures either technical or human in nature with regard to the online examinations.
7. The organizers reserve the right at any time during the competition to disqualify a participant at its sole discretion if the said participant has not adhered to the rules and regulations.
8. The winners consent that their names and photographs may be used in IOBSL related media such as, but not limited to the website, newsletter and social media.
9. Liability: The organizers of this competition shall not be liable for any loss or damage sustained by participants as a result of participating in the competition.
