| <b>Type</b>       | Original biology-related images taken by the submitting member with a short description of what is depicted  |
| <b>Resolution</b> | Images of 300 dpi (dots-per-inch) or higher. When taking photos, make sure that your camera is set to take large-format photos. Should not resample (change the dpi settings) of your photos |
| <b>Submission</b> | Submit jpegs either as a zipped file or individually.  |
