Structure of the Feature Article	
Title	Attractive title
	Highlights the main idea of the article
Introduction	Outlines the subject or theme of the article
Body	Description of the topic
	Written in short paragraphs
	Divide into subheadings
	Facts and statistics
	Photographs, tables, diagrams, and graphs (without Copyright Infringement)
	Anecdotes and stories
Conclusion	A reminder of the article's main idea
	Take-home message
Bibliography	Maximum 8, APA style

Structure of the Updates on Latest Research	
Body	Summary of your latest research
	Can be divided into subheadings
	Be concise
Bibliography	Maximum 8, APA style

Photographs	
Type	Original biology-related images taken by the submitting member with a short description of what is depicted
Resolution	Images of 300 dpi (dots-per-inch) or higher. When taking photos, make sure that your camera is set to take large-format photos. Should not resample (change the dpi settings) of your photos
Submission	Submit jpegs either as a zipped file or individually. Submission of images/jpegs in a Word document is not encouraged
